68. Apologies

No apologies were received.

69. Declarations of Interest

70. Minutes

It was **RESOLVED:** That the minutes of the meeting held on 27th February 2008 be signed as a true record.

PUBLIC SESSION:

Mr I McLaren spoke of his objections to the modifications and closures as proposed by Hampshire County Council for footpaths in the parish.

71. Chairman's Remarks

The Chairman expressed her congratulations to all the agencies involved in the very successful Fun Day held at Gang Warily on Saturday 10th May, with donations made to the Honeypot charity. It was anticipated that this would lead to a regular event and suggested that coverage be extended to the whole of the Waterside.

72. Planning

It was **RESOLVED** that comments be submitted as follows:

a) Parish List:

The Parish Council SUPPORT the application.

We recommend PERMISSION on the grounds that a property had previously been on site and the proposal is not out of keeping with the area.

i) Hampshire County Council: Request for observations on the following application: Replacement Shredder Plant and Equipment at Pyros Environmental Limited, Charleston Road, Hardley, Hythe, SO45 3ZA
RESOLVED: To support the proposal. Cllrs M Fidler and A Glass to monitor through the Environmental Health Committee.

ii) Hampshire County Council: Invitation to Hampshire Woodland Forum, Lyndhurst Community Centre 22nd May 9.45-1600.
The invitation was noted.

iii) New Forest National Park: Notification of appeal regarding 07/92129: Resource recycling, recovery and transfer facility in association with landscaping business, one storey office and other ancillary development. Hampshire Turf, Northern Access Road, Fawley.
RESOLVED: To recommend rejection of the appeal on the grounds of traffic noise and vehicular movements and to request sending a representative to speak at the appeal.

iv) New Forest District Council: Notification of Appeal in respect of tree works at 51 Hobson Way, Holbury.
The proposal was previously supported and no further observations made.

b) For information:

- i) **New Forest District Council:** Notification of temporary road closure C119 Hampton Lane/Lepe Road between junction with Thornbury Avenue and its junction with Walkers Lane South, starting on 20th May and for 4.5 days. Notices had been duly posted. Concern was expressed at the possible impact on late night parking.
- ii) **New Forest District Council:** Supplementary Planning Document: The provision of car parking space in residential development.

74. **Extinguishment and Diversions of Footpaths and Bridleways on Cadland Estate:** Members discussed Cllr Holtham's report and recommendations for comments to Hampshire County Council.

It was **RESOLVED** that Cllr Holtham represent the Parish and that the following comments be submitted, as well as a copy of the report.

That the Parish Council endorsed the report and supported the changes, with the exception of the extinguishment of Footpath 18a between Footpath 21 and Mopley Pond, between points P & Q on map 3.

75. **Monthly Sales Values for February and March 2008**
Following discussion the Monthly Sales Values for February & March 2008 were noted and agreed.

76. **Use of sun-beds.**

The Chairman reported on concerns raised relating to Health and Safety issues and the need to consider whether the provision of a sun-bed should continue at Gang Warily. It was agreed that further information on the implications for removal and the recommendations for local authorities be sought and that this be referred to the Parish Council for consideration.

It was **RESOLVED:** That the Committee recommend consideration of the removal of the sun-bed and that this be discussed at the next meeting of the Parish Council.
