## Priorities for Hythe and surrounding areas include:

- To prevent, reduce and detect anti social behaviour and under age drinking at the QE2 recreation ground
- To tackle youth nuisance problems around the Tesco Express in North Road, Dibden Purlieu
- To reduce anti social behaviour and youth nuisance in High Street, Hythe, focussing on the area around Waitrose
- To reduce reports of criminal damage and nuisance in Reed Drive, Marchwood

These are the priorities that people in your local area have agreed with the Safer Neighbourhoods team. You can influence these priorities by contacting your team, attending a meeting or speaking to members of the team when you see them out and about.

Hello and welcome to the latest Fawley Parish Newsletter.

The parish seems to be split in this report with Holbury and Hardley experiencing very low levels of crime and anti-social behaviour while Fawley and Blackfield has seen an increase.

In Blackfield a local man has been arrested and police bailed following a robbery at around 11pm on August 12 in Hampton Lane. Anyone who has information which may assist the investigation should contact DC Norridge of New Forest CID on 101.

The Fawley area has had a higher number of assaults but are of a minor nature, with several resulting from one incident where one person has been reported and others have not wishing to assist police. At Calshot beach, two people were assaulted in separate incidents, one in a dispute over parking where the offender has been summonsed to court and in the second police found a man with a black eye who declined to assist police.

On the Cadland estate land there have been a number of incidents where someone is deliberately starting fires. This not only puts a strain on the local fire service resources, it also causes considerable environmental damage and potentially puts local lives at risk.

We are working closely with Hardley Fire Station and following various lines of enquiry to identify the offender(s) and reduce further incidents. If anyone has information that will assist, please contact us.



The fires account for the majority of damage incidents while a further four involve an incident in Blackfield Road and Newlands Close linked to an assault and one where an occupant caused damage to property in a family home.

We are also noticing an increase in reports of rowdy and inconsiderate behaviour around licensed premises, loud music late at night, or involving people who have been drinking and causing noise late at night and into the early hours.



To deal with this, Hythe SNT is actively patrolling identified hotspots and visiting licensed premises and noisy dwellings to provide suitable advice.

NFDC environmental health will also be informed

and they have enforcement powers which can result in the seizure of equipment or prosecution for public order offences which can result in an £80 fixed penalty notice or a day in court, which happened to one resident of Heather Road recently.

To finish on a road safety note, we are noticing an increasing number of people who are failing to wear their seat belt which carries a £60 penalty.



Each year hundreds of people are involved in collisions and lose their lives through failure to wear a seat belt. For the sake of protecting your life, please make sure you 'belt-up' next time you go out in your car.
