

Control of Major Accident Hazards Regulations 2015

The refining and petrochemical industries in this area manufacture and store hazardous substances. This card is produced in accordance with the above regulations to advise you what to do in the unlikely event of a major accident on their premises that could affect the public.

Please read this card carefully and follow the instructions given overleaf if the emergency alarm is sounded.

The **alarm** will be a two-tone warble.

The **“all clear”** will be a single tone.

Householders should make sure all occupants understand the instructions. Responsible persons in business/community premises should also be familiar with the actions required, so that they may instruct occupants in the event of an incident.

This card should be kept in an accessible place and passed on to subsequent occupiers. It should be prominently displayed in business/community premises. Additional copies may be obtained from:

Emergency instructions

If you hear the emergency alarm:

The **alarm** will be a two-tone warble.

The **“all clear”** will be a single tone.

- a. Go immediately into a house or building.

- b. Close all doors to the outside.

- c. Close all windows and pull curtains across windows facing the Fawley site.

- d. Turn off any ventilation system or air conditioning unit that draws in air from the outside.

- e. Stay in a room that does not face the Fawley site. Remain indoors until you hear the “all clear” or until you receive instructions from the Police. Doors and windows may then be opened to restore ventilation.

- f. While waiting for the “all clear”:
 - Tune in to BBC Radio Solent (96.1 MHz FM, 999MW, digital radio and online), which will be used to broadcast information or instructions.
 - Avoid using the telephone until the “all clear” is given, to ensure lines are free for the emergency services.
 - Incident updates will be issued by our multi-agency partners using social media channels (Twitter / Facebook).

- g. Please co-operate fully with the instructions given by the emergency services.
